

INFORMATION SHEET “INCIDENTAL CHARGES / HAZARDOUS GOODS”

HAZARDOUS GOODS SURCHARGES / SAFETY SURCHARGES

For shipments with hazardous goods (pursuant to ADR, RID or IMDG), a surcharge will be levied in certain cases. The currently known surcharges for hazardous goods shipments as at 01.01.2009 are indicated separately in the corresponding price lists. In the event that additional surcharges should become necessary, we will notify you promptly. The surcharges will be shown separately in the billing statement. The regulations for hazardous goods surcharges of foreign terminals can be found in the respective pricing rules of Kombiverkehr.

EARLY DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF LOADING UNITS WITH HAZARDOUS GOODS

The customer has a duty to deliver loading units with hazardous goods on the day of dispatch only and to collect such loading units immediately upon arrival. Any exceptions must be agreed directly with the relevant terminal operator (the contact details for the terminals can be found in the Internet under www.kombiverkehr.de > Customer Information > Terminals & Agencies).

The regulations for early delivery and pickup in DUSS terminals are set out in the section entitled “Early delivery of loading units with hazardous goods at DUSS terminals” and “Demurrage for the belated pickup of loading units with hazardous goods in DUSS terminals”.

EARLY DELIVERY OF LOADING UNITS WITH HAZARDOUS GOODS AT DUSS TERMINALS

Loading units with hazardous goods can normally only be delivered to DUSS terminals earlier than the actual dispatch date by prior agreement with the local Kombiverkehr agency. Units containing hazardous goods must be delivered no more than 24 hours before the close of loading for the dispatch date, subject to available storage capacity. Please note that early deliveries of hazardous goods units for departure by rail are only exempt from storage charges on the dispatch date itself. In the event of delivery before the dispatch date, storage fees and an additional handling charge as set out in the published price list for storage services will be levied (see Internet under www.kombiverkehr.de > Downloads > incidental charges).

DEMURRAGE FOR THE BELATED PICKUP OF LOADING UNITS WITH HAZARDOUS GOODS IN DUSS TERMINALS

Hazardous goods units shall be picked up at the DUSS terminals on the day of arrival, but in any event no later than during the opening hours of the following business day. If loading units are not picked up during this period, a demurrage fee in the amount of EUR 20 per loading unit and calendar day will be charged. In the case of gateway traffic, only the ultimate terminal is affected, in the case of transshipments (combined shipments), the transshipment terminals are also affected.

Example gateway traffic:

transportation from terminal A → terminal C via terminal B

At terminal B, there will be no demurrage fee.

At terminal C (ultimate destination terminal), the demurrage fee will be charged if the demurrage-free time period is exceeded.

Example transshipment:

Transportation from terminal A → terminal B and from terminal B → terminal C

The customer books two fare stages. At terminal B (transshipment terminal) and C (ultimate destination terminal), the demurrage fee will be charged if the demurrage-free time period is exceeded.

After the first chargeable day, every further calendar day (including the day of collection) will be charged.

A distinction will also be made between availability of a loading unit before and after 18.00 h. Please refer to the following tables for more information.

**SPECIAL RULES AT THE TRANSSHIPMENT STATION
DUISBURG-RUHRORT HAFEN UBF DUSS**

At the transshipment station Duisburg-Ruhrort Hafen Ubf DUSS, there is a separation between the storage at the crane runway (without hazardous goods loading units) and the depot area. The transfer to the depot, to which also empty, uncleaned hazardous goods loading units may be moved for storage in transit, must be ordered by the customer through advance notice to DUSS. In this way, the demurrage charge can be avoided. If there is no customer order for transfer and storage, a demurrage fee in the amount of EUR 50 per loading unit will be charged in accordance with the storage fee regulation.
